Our selection of artesian sakes represents a millennia of brewing excellence. The subtle nuances of great sakes are like snow flakes, no two are ever alike!

### Honjozo

A style of sake brewed with a very small amount of alcohol to soften and enhance the flavors and aromas.

#### 701 Kasumi Tsuru "Kimoto Extra Dry" (Kobe) Kyogo

Established 1775, only a handful of brewers continue to use this original "Kimoto" method of production; long, layered and rich, with a balance of smoky and fruity aromas. Glass 9 | 1.8L Bottle 90

### Junmai

Purest local water, unique strains of sake rice polished to a minimum of 70%. Firm, robust, complex, the original style of all sake.

#### 702 Shichi Hon Yari "Seven Spearsmen" Shiga

Established 1540, the oldest and smallest producer in Japan. A perfect introduction to sake; fresh mushroom nose opens to grapefruit and melon on the palate. Glass 10 | 1.8L Bottle 110

#### 703 Taiheikai Tokubetsu "Pacific Ocean" Ibaraki

Founded 1854, this special production sake is fresh and fruity with a slight nuttiness. Glass 12 | 720mL Bottle 55

#### 704 Chikurin Fukamai "Depth" Okayama

Founded 1867, great with oysters, snapper, or sashimi. An elegant style with a tangy edge. 300 mL Bottle 30

### Junmai Ginjo

Finest sake rice polished to 60% minimum, attaining refinement and balance. Subtle power and concentration with seductive length of palate.

#### 705 Yuki No Bosha "Limited Release" Akita

5<sup>th</sup> Generation, rich and layered, mellow fruit with rustic spice, white pepper and hints of tarragon in the finish. Glass 2 | 1.8L Bottle 120

#### 706 Huchu Homare Watari Bune "55" Ibaraki

Watari Bune is Japan's rarest and most prized sake rice, revived from near extinction. Rich, deep notes of pineapple and subtle nutty flavors. Glass 15 | 720mL Bottle 70

#### 707 Kasumi Tsuru "Yamahai" (Kobe) Hyogo

Handmade since 1725, Yamada Nishiki rice, highly aromatic balance of earth and fruit. A wilder, gamier version of the Kasumi Tsuru Kimoto. 720mL Bottle 70

### Junmai Daiginjo

Most delicate and highly refined of all sake. Polished to 50% minimum, often showing aromas of exotic flowers or fresh tropical fruits.

#### 708 Mu "Nothingness" Hyogo

Starts very floral, yet finishes clean and dry. This highly prized sake is one of the finest in the world. Glass 15 | 720mL Bottle 60

#### 709 Wakatake Onikoroshi "Demon Slayer" Shizuoka

Beautifully round and alluring sake with a silky texture. Deep taste and slight sweetness stemming from elegant, fruity aromas and superb acidity. Glass 16 | 720mL Bottle 75 | 1.8L Bottle 180

#### 710 Yuki No Bosha "Akita Komachi" Akita

An exceptionally beautiful sake, inspired by the beautiful women of Akita and the rare rice used to produce it. Refined and elegant, aromatic. 720mL Bottle 120

#### 711 Huchu Homare "Watari Bune" Ibaraki

Among the most prized of all Daiginjos in the sake world. Deep luscious and layered with well balanced fruit flavors of honeydew, peaches and pineapple. 720mL Bottle 200

### Nigori

Paired well with desserts, these sakes are slightly dry to sinfully sweet. Unfiltered and a bit wild.

#### 712 Yeagaki Nigori Hyogo

Creamy texture with a touch of sweetness. Glass 12 | 720mL Bottle 40

#### 714 Yuki No Bosha Nigori Akita

Not snow, but a silver "fog". Delicate and dry in style. 300mL Bottle 28

### Sparkling Sake

Sake made in the style of champagne, frothy and delicious.

#### 720 Hatsumago, Yamagata

A well balanced Nigori style sake. 720mL 18

#### 721 Hana Hou Hou Shu, Okayama

A delicately tart Nigori style sake infused with rose hips and hibiscus blossoms. 300mL Bottle 24

#### 722 Okunomatsu, Junmai Daiginjo, Fukushima

Developed for the express purpose of allowing the winner of Japan's premier F1 auto race to spray sake and not champagne in the winner's celebration. Higher alcohol content and powerful fizz. 720mL Bottle 250
